Grace, peace, and mercy by yours in abundance! This month we begin our Lenten journey with Ash Wednesday on February 14 at 7:00. We will receive the imposition of ashes and hear the words "remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return." At the heart of the liturgy is an invitation to attend our own "white funeral" and to die to ourselves. We are to turn from your sin and turn toward God, In the introduction I will read: "As disciples of Jesus, we are called to a discipline that contends against evil and resists whatever leads us away from love of God and neighbor. I invite you, therefore, to the discipline of Lent—self-examination and repentance, prayer and fasting, sacrificial giving and works of love—strengthened by the gifts of word and sacrament. Let us continue our journey through these forty days to the great Three Days of Jesus' death and resurrection."

It is ironic that the first day of Lent is also Valentine's Day. We are showing our ultimate love for God and His love by taking seriously the sacrifice and suffering of Jesus. It is a time to rekindle the flame and passion of our faith and devotion to serve God with all our heart, soul, and mind. I want to encourage you during this season to cultivate a daily discipline of devotional reading of God's Word. We can all read through the New Testament together in approximately 30 minutes a day. I have given you a guide to follow. Invite the Holy Spirit to speak giving insight, knowledge and understanding. Spend five minutes praying for Emmanuel Lutheran Church and our mission: To Glorify God and spread God's Word to all by the power of the Holy Spirit." May God richly bless us on our Lenten journey.


