Dear friends in Christ,

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ! Today is also Maundy Thursday, when Jesus celebrates the Last supper with his disciples before his suffering and death on the cross. The word 'Maundy' means "to obey." Jesus washes his disciple's feet as a servant and commands them to do likewise. He commands them to love one another as he has loved them. He commands them to remember this night by partaking of bread and wine whenever they gather thus instituting the sacrament of Holy Communion. During this meal Judas is revealed as the one who will betray Jesus. This act sets in motion the forces set against Jesus. Tomorrow is Good Friday; the most solemn days of Holy Week. It's ironic that Monday is April Fool's Day because God gets the last laugh in what appears to be a victory for Satan as Jesus is betrayed, arrested, beaten, found guilty on trumped up charges and sentenced to death by crucifixion. He suffers and dies on the cross as a common criminal. It seems that Satan has won. And yet it is in this very death that Jesus, the sacrificial Lamb of God, shed his blood for the remission of our sins. He paid the price for the punishment that we deserve for human sin. On Good Friday, we contemplate our sin being nailed to the cross with Jesus. We then wait with anticipation for the resurrection. The power of sin, death and evil does not win. The power of God vindicates His Son, and raises Him from the dead. God made a way for humanity to be reconciled to Himself by believing and having faith in Jesus.

In the Gospel according to Mark, we read the account of Jesus resurrection. The women come to the grave and find the stone rolled away. An angel of the Lord tells them: "Don't be alarmed. You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here...go tell the disciples he is going ahead of you to Galilee. There you will see him as he told you." Then Mark says: "Trembling and bewildered, the women went out and fled from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid." That is the end of the story. They told no one. The Gospel writer purposefully has an abrupt ending to cause the listener or reader to ask: "How could they keep this good news to themselves?" Indeed, it is a question we too must ask of ourselves as ones who have heard the story and come to believe that Jesus died of ours sins on the cross and rose again giving us new life and the promise of salvation. As we celebrate this Easter the death and resurrection of our Lord and Savior, let us not keep it to ourselves. Go and tell somebody that Jesus is alive! He is with us. We no longer need to be ruled by fear. Let us proclaim boldly to the world: "He is risen! He is risen indeed!!!"


